Abstract submission dates & requirements:

Do you have an interesting story to tell, be it a marvellous success or gruesome failure? Then present at this year's CO-OPS National Workshop. Your colleagues can learn from your successes and particularly the bits you'd do differently next time.

Presentations will be for 20 minutes plus questions, alternately you could present a poster. Register your intent to submit on the registration form. Follow the deadlines as listed in the box.

How to submit an abstract

Your abstract needs to be submitted by 4pm on August 20. It should be 300 words or less in Microsoft word format. Send as an attachment by email to admin@co-ops.net.au quoting "National Workshop – Abstract / Poster" in the subject line. Include the following details:

- Is your initiative/s located in an urban, rural or remote location?
- In which State or Territory does your initiative/s take place?
- Identify which population group/s the initiative/s primarily works with i.e. a specific age cohort, CALD group

Presentation or poster structure

Include the following points:

- The need for the initiative/s
- Demonstrate the local impacts of the issue/s the initiative has or seeks to address
- How the initiative came about
- What you/others did
- Peculiarities about the initiative i.e. community demographic, location, agency involvement (or lack of)
- What happened as a result of the initiative
- What is the legacy of the project
